Deadlines

Entry Deadline with Entrance Fee: **Friday, September 2nd, 2022**
Wine Delivery Deadline: **Monday, September 12th, 2022**

Wine MUST be delivered by Monday, September 12th, in order to be judged.

General Rules

- All competitors must be amateur winemakers. Upon entry, the competitor declares that his/her entries were made in a home winemaking situation and not by a winery or commercial entity.
- All competitors must reside in Ontario County.
- Wines must be made from grapes grown in the Finger Lakes exclusively.
- All judging will be blind tastings. No labels on the bottles. They will be numbered and tracked by the event chairperson.
- Two wine categories will be judged in 2022 - Red wines and White wines.
- There is a limit of two (2) entries per competitor.
- One (1) 750 ml bottle of each wine entered must be submitted for judging. The only exception will be Dessert wines which will be accepted in 375 ml bottles.
- Judging to be completed on-site and awards presented at the end of the competition.
- By entering, your information and picture may be used to promote current and future events.
